









Short Term, Hands-on Keratoplasty Training Program (3 months)

Objective: Training Ophthalmologists with a hands-on keratoplasty fellowship training program *and* Facilitating corneal tissue availability to trained surgeons

Eligibility criteria:

MS/DNB/DO in Ophthalmology

Must have done over 2000 cataract surgeries

Clinic / Hospital with over 100 OPD patients daily

Geographic location of practice in an area deprived of corneal surgeons with high demand of service

National Organ & Tissue Transplant Organization (NOTTO) registration (or applied for NOTTO registration prior to commencement of training)

- -OT (observation + hands on)
- -Cornea clinic observership
- -Competency based assessment
- -Enable the surgeon to receive corneal tissue
- -Eye Bank overview
- -Academic classes
